

AVIS/KAVIS Transition

Due to the Commonwealth Office of Technology (COT) and the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) installing a new Vehicle Title and Registration System in January 2024, the Oldham County Clerk's office is alerting drivers and dealers across the county about an upcoming planned shutdown of the current system (AVIS). The shutdown, part of the transition that will bring the new Kentucky Automated Vehicle Information System (KAVIS) online, will mean that county clerk offices across Kentucky cannot issue decals, plates, disabled parking permits, and registrations, nor process vehicle transfers after December 29, 2023 to their "GO LIVE" date.

Oldham County is scheduled to "GO LIVE" with KAVIS on January 10, 2024 at 8am. With that being said the Crestwood and Prospect offices will be closed to the public January 1st thru January 9th. The LaGrange office will be closed January 1st & 2nd for holiday and will be open 8am to 12pm January 3rd thru January 9th (excluding weekends) for all other services including recordings, voter registration and passports.

NO MOTOR VEHICLES TRANSACTION WILL OCCUR DECEMBER 30TH THRU JANUARY 9TH.

The online motor vehicle registration renewal portal will be taken offline at midnight, December 27, 2023 and will go back live on January 8, 2024.

I encourage everyone who has motor vehicle title work or registration renewals to process to do so now and not wait until January.

- All work to be processed in 2023 must be dropped off by <u>12:00 p.m.</u> on Monday, December 18, 2023
- All dealer accounts receivable/money due must be paid by <u>12:00 p.m.</u> Wednesday, December 27, 2023
