1 LEGAL ABSENTEE BALLOTS

This is not common. Absentee ballots will be restricted to legal valid reasons only. Refer to the back for the full list of qualifications.

General Absentee Voting is April 6th–May 7th, 2024.

2 “NO EXCUSE” EARLY VOTING

Any registered voter can choose to vote early, with no excuse needed.

4 “EXCUSED VOTING:” MAY 8, 9, 10, 13, 14 & 15TH. HB564 allows registered voters who meet specific requirements to vote early at 100 W. Jefferson Street in LaGrange, during regular business hours. Voters must meet the HB564 requirements to be eligible.

ABSENTEE VOTING REQUIREMENTS

If one of these reasons applies to you, please request a ballot through the portal. If it does not, you must vote at the early voting location or at a polling center on election day.

You may request your absentee ballot through a secured portal at GoVote.ky.gov April 6th–May 7th, 2024.

LAWFUL REASONS TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

- Voter who is a resident of Kentucky who is a covered voter as defined in KRS 117A.010.
- Not able to appear at the polls on election day or the days in-person absentee voting is conducted on the account of age, disability, or illness, and who has not been declared mentally disabled by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- Student who temporarily resides outside of the county of his/her residence.
- Voter who temporarily resides outside the state but is still eligible to vote in this state.
- Person who is incarcerated in jail and has been charged with a crime, but has not been convicted of the crime
- Person whose employment location requires him or her to be absent from the county all hours of all days absentee voting by machine is conducted
- Person who is a participant in the Office of the Secretary of State's address confidentiality program.
